Dear Sir,

I am writing to you with regards to the proposed traveller's site at Penylan. Could I officially object to the location of Penylan being used as a Traveller site, now and for the future.

My main objection would be the access from the site of Traveller's vehicles onto what is now a very busy road. It is the only road leading from the west to a usually packed Trostre Shopping Area. There will be an increase in traffic with in the next year and a half due to the new building of Pentre Awel. This will affect the traffic flow and road safety on a very busy road.

There are also plans for a replacement bridge at Morfa. This will increase the number of the public using this area, in order to connect to the new cycle path / walkways in PENYFAN.

There could be social community problems, where there could be community impact on the Traveller's themselves, by existing residents who have opposed the site. Possibly seen as a blight for visitors that visit Trostre Enterprise Park and Pentre Awel. The site is a natural habitat for wildlife. The site is also too close to an already densely populated area. The site would devalue properties and be detrimental to the wellbeing of local residents.
