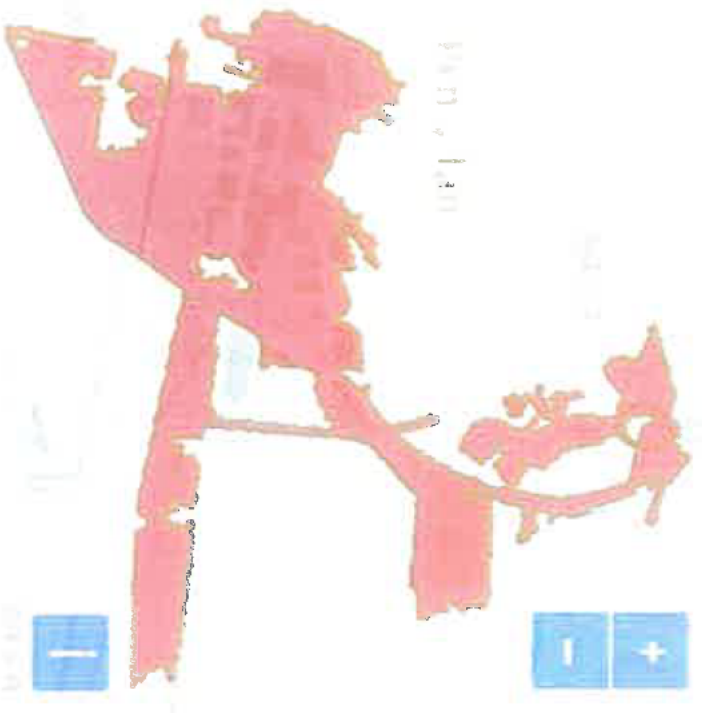

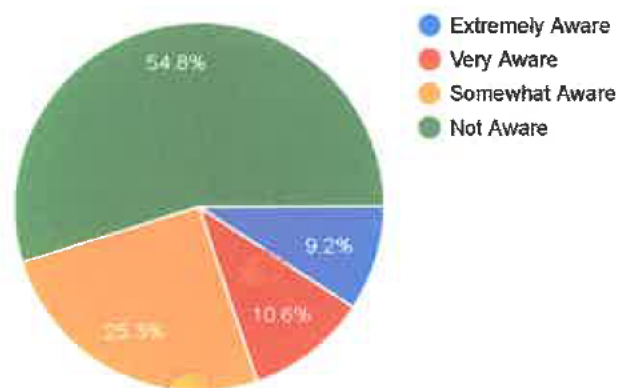

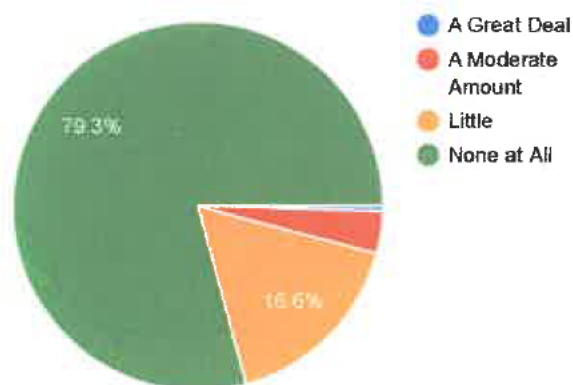

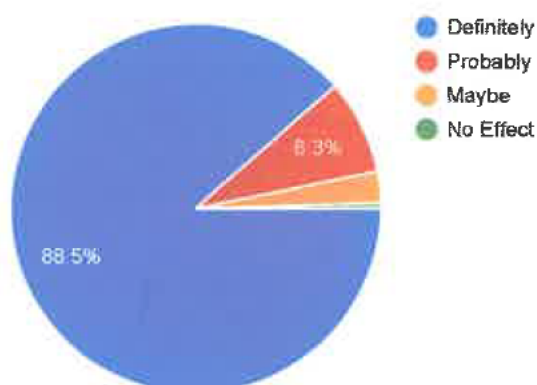

Do you think the large scale development will have have an adverse effect on wildlife in the area?



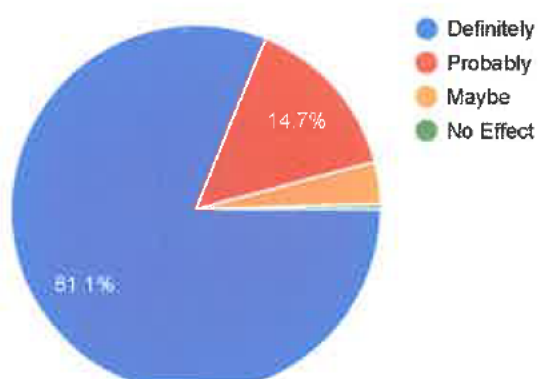

Do you think the proposed development will cause an increase in traffic and pollution on Trostre Road?



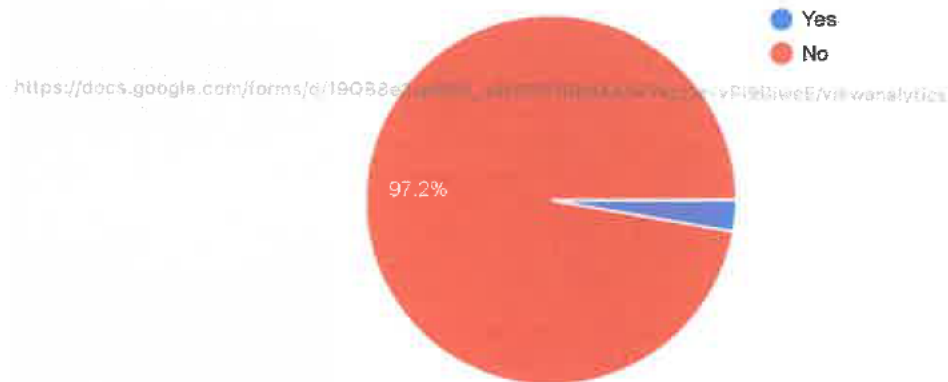

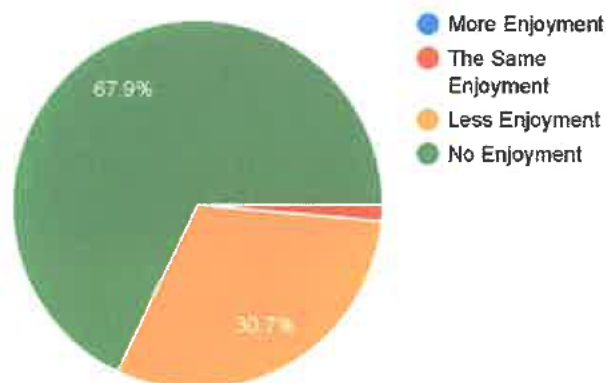

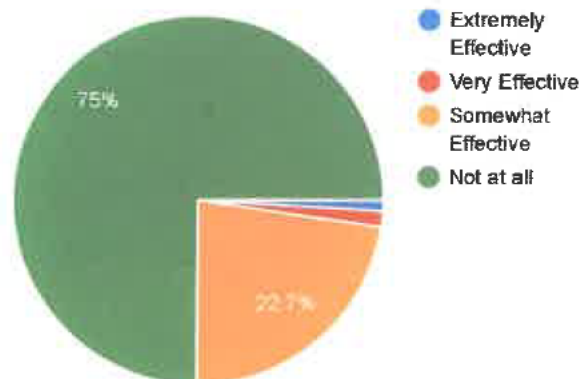

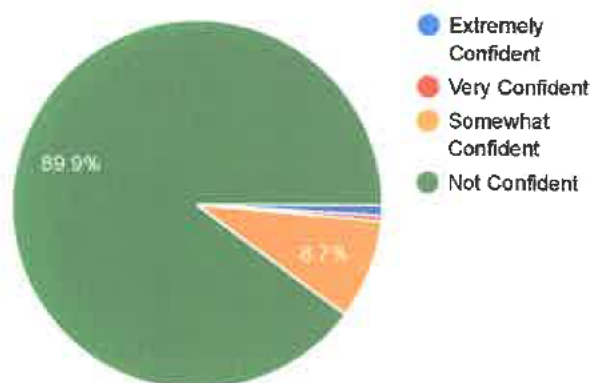

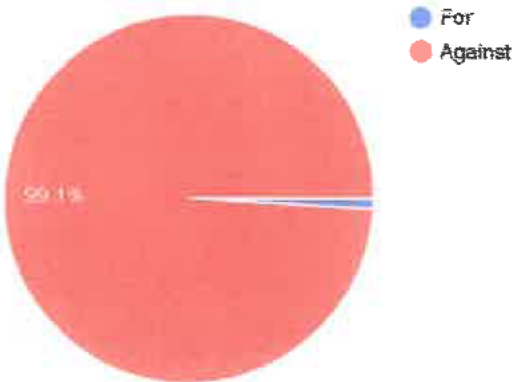
