Revised Carmarthenshire Local Development Plan (LDP) 2018 – 2033

As you may be aware, Carmarthenshire County Council's Revised LDP 2018-2033 is subject to an independent examination and hearing sessions took place in October and November 2024, and in September 2025.

The Council has compiled a Schedule of Matters Arising Changes (MACs) primarily as a result of Action Points arising from the Examination Hearing Sessions. These changes are required to make the Plan sound and have all been agreed with the appointed Inspectors of the examination.

In conjunction with these MACs, we are also consulting on updates to the following supporting documents:

3. Integrated Sustainability Appraisal (ISA) addendum to the MACs
4. Habitats Regulation Assessment (HRA) addendum to the MACs

The consultation will start on 11th May 2026 and close at 11.59pm on 26th June 2026. **Please note that the consultation is for commenting on the MACs, the ISA addendum and the HRA addendum only.** Any correspondence relating to other elements of the Plan will be deemed as not duly made.

Comments on the published documents should be submitted in writing, preferably using our online consultation tools.
