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Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for consulting DCWW on the proposed MACs. Please find attached our representations, which have also been submitted online.

We note that the MACs include the addition of appendix 9 & 10 to include details of '*key considerations and constraints*' to allocated site delivery. We have highlighted in our previous representations on the LDP the expected water and sewerage infrastructure requirements for the proposed sites, such as the requirement for Hydraulic Modelling Assessments (HMAs) to be undertaken on foul sewer/clean water networks. There are some sites where our comments haven't been reflected in the MAC Appendix, and those have been highlighted in our attached response.

Whilst we have not undertaken reassessment of the proposed allocated sites, there are some changes regarding WwTW capacities that we are aware of, and it would be prudent to include the latest situation into the appendix:

- AMP8 investment schemes are planned for delivery at Llannant, Whitland and Laugharne WwTWs by March 2030.
- Limited capacity at Adpar WwTW.

Notwithstanding the above, it should be noted that the demand upon our infrastructure is continually changing, and we will reassess sites and provide representations when planning applications are submitted. The LDP is also planned to be supported by an Infrastructure Delivery Plan to provide further detail of the phasing, funding and delivery of infrastructure required for each key site, and we are happy to contribute to this document in due course.
